Whether you're a total beginner or an experienced potter, you'll have a great time at MCG. Although we tend to gravitate towards wheel throwing and functional pottery, you are welcome to create hand-built ornamental and sculptural work as well. Works made in this class will be high-fired in our gas kiln so they'll look great and be microwave and dishwasher safe. We'll also do some raku firing, which is an exciting process that leads to interesting and often beautiful results.

3-D MODELING AND LASER ENGRAVING

Learn to design and create three-dimensional art-work using Autodesk software. Print your designs on a variety of 3-D printers or process them for cutting on the laser cutter and engraver. Work with a variety of materials including PLA plastic, ABS plastic, acrylic and various woods. Some of the projects include lamps (hanging and table top), ornaments, game boards with playing pieces, night lights, decorative bowls, and more. Let us help your 3-D creative ideas become reality!

Bring in your own camera or use one of ours. In this course you'll learn how to use the manual functions on an SLR camera. We'll go on field trips to practice capturing images and you'll have the opportunity to use our fully equipped black and white darkroom. You'll also have access to our digital darkroom, where you can process and print your work. You'll learn programs such as Adobe Bridge and Photoshop and talk about other editing and cataloging programs.
